This is in reply to your letter (fax) of March 9, 1999 wherein you requested an update opinion on the acceptability of the subject of PVC compound for use in the manufacture of containers intended for packaging foods such as water, spices, edible oil, fruit juices, port, sherry and wines.

Based on the information that we have on file at present respecting its composition, and on the understanding that this composition has not changed since it was last submitted to us on November 16, 1987, we can advise that we see no reason to object to the use of the subject compound in the food packaging applications specified above, provided that it is technically suitable for those intended end uses.
